What is the problem?

Tenants reliant on electric storage heating and hot water systems have an unsatisfactory and expensive heating experience:

Your existing electric storage heaters are **NOT** the problem.

What is the solution?

How does HeatSage work?

HeatSage analyses three variables to optimise the low-cost charging opportunities provided by a tariff. This radically enhances the heating experience for each of your tenants.

The variables are:

- The tenant's heating preferences
- The tenant's living room temperature
- Tomorrow's local average temperature

Installation of **HeatSage** is straightforward, with minimal disruption to your tenants. It consists of:

- A small **temperature and humidity sensor** in the tenant's living room
- A **smart controller** (load switch) on the tenant's electricity meter board
- A digital **communications gateway**
